The fact of its having become necessary to issue this the 14th edition, of this brief Guide to Vienna and its Environs is in itself an evidence of its usefulness and practical value to English-speaking travellers. In this carefully revised edition particular care has been taken from the very beginning to familiarize the readers with the customs and peculiarities of Vienna, so as to protect them as far as possible, from misconceptions and extortions.
