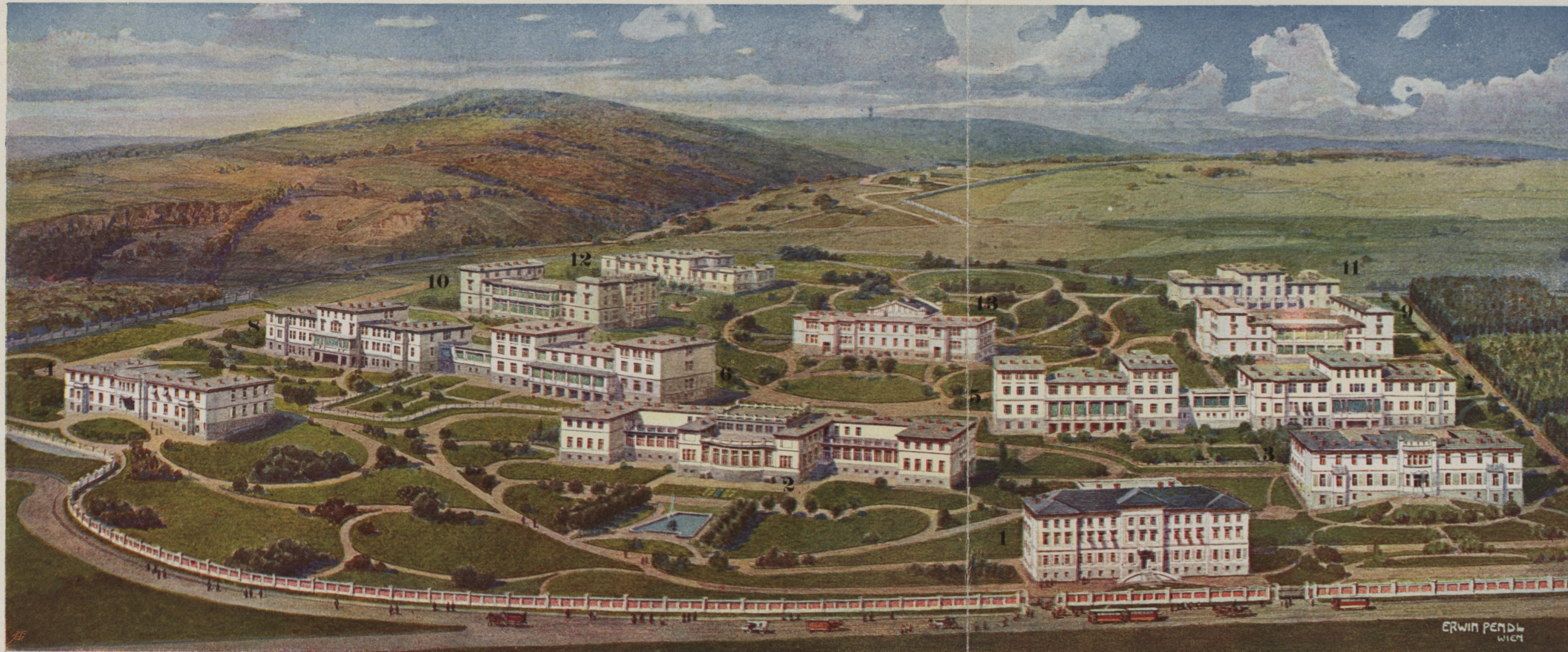

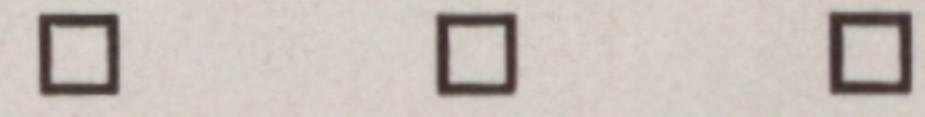
The villas and pavillions 3, 5, 7, 9, 11 are for Ladies, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12 are reserved for Gentlemen.

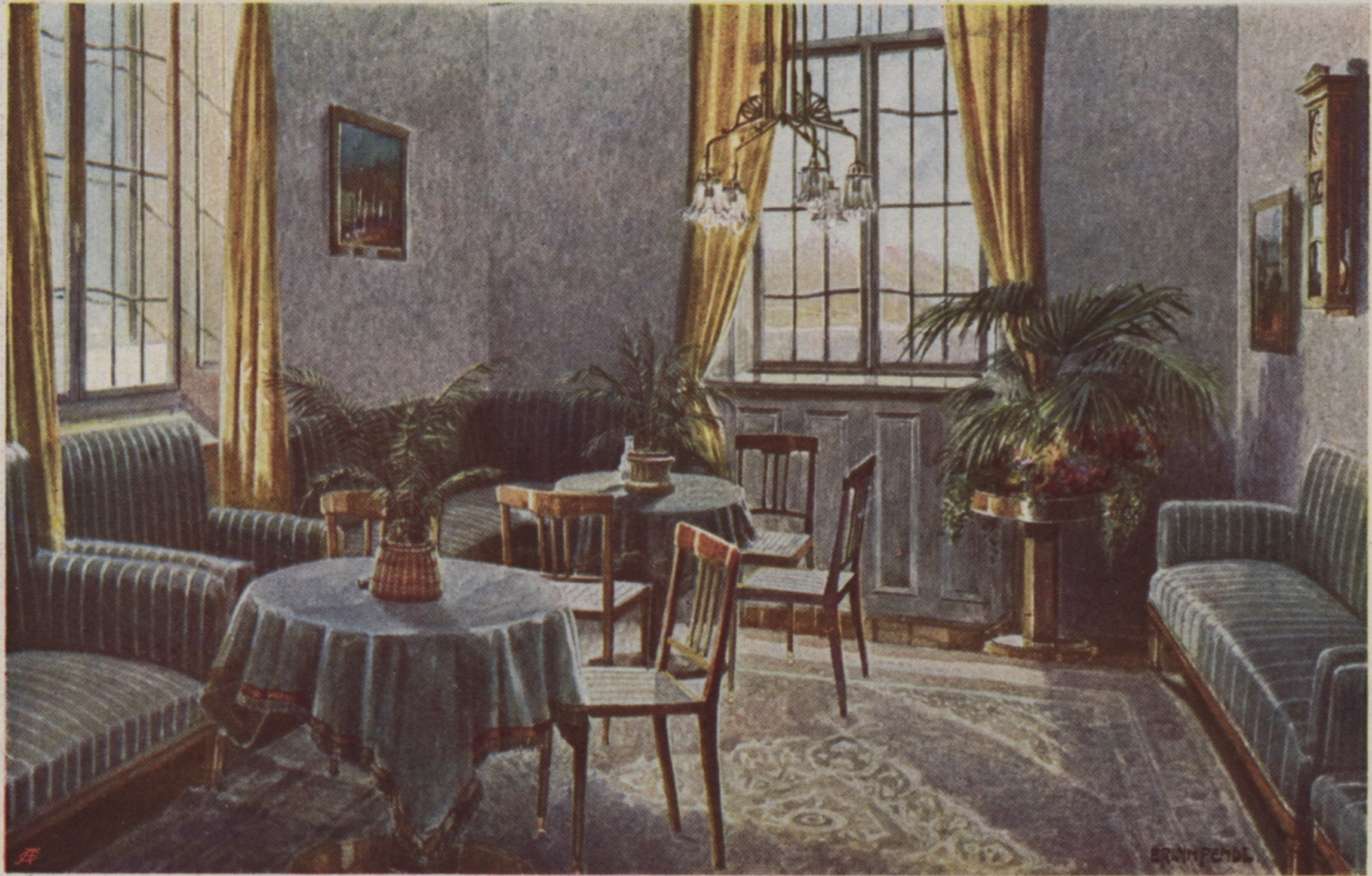

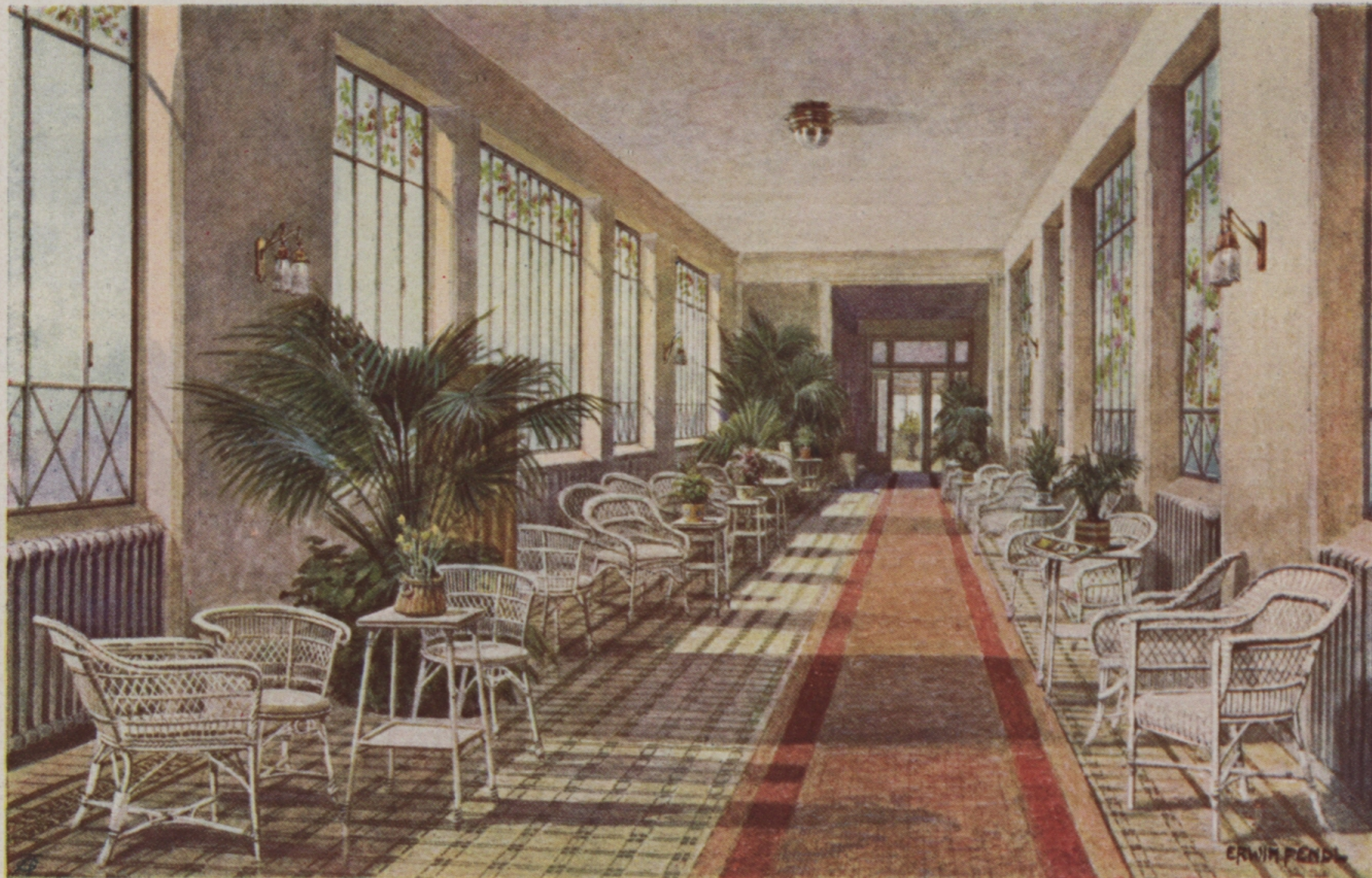

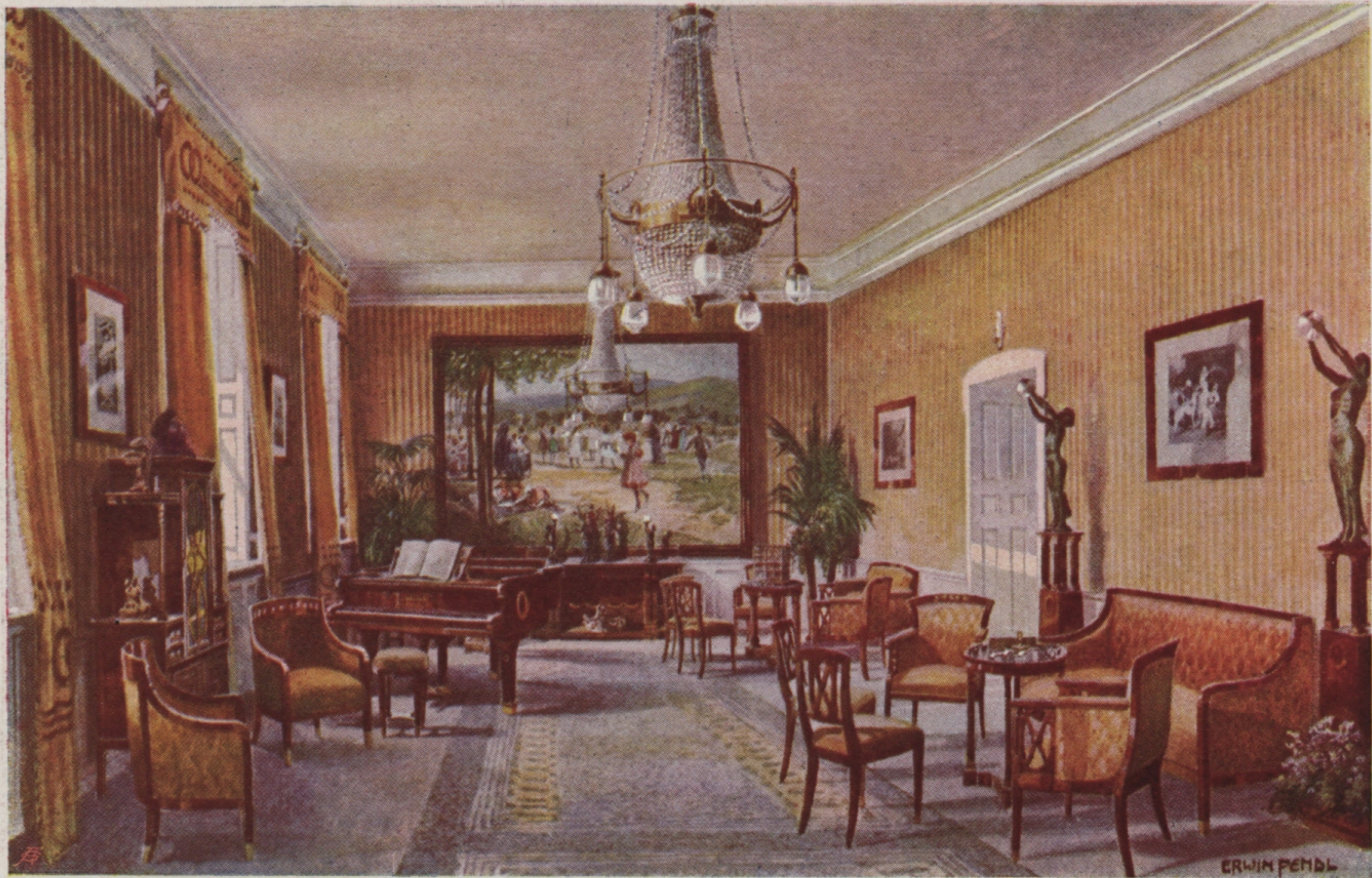

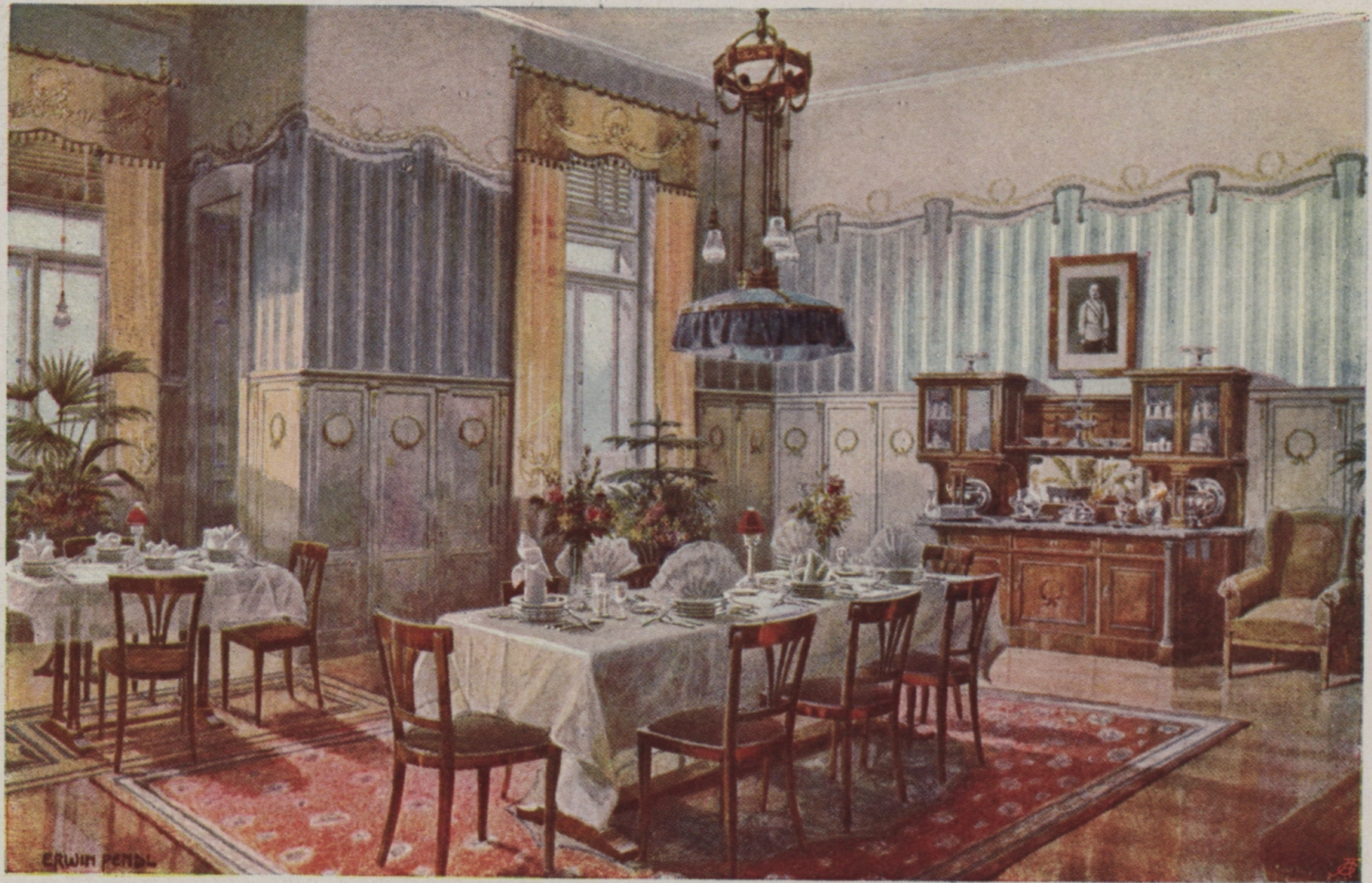

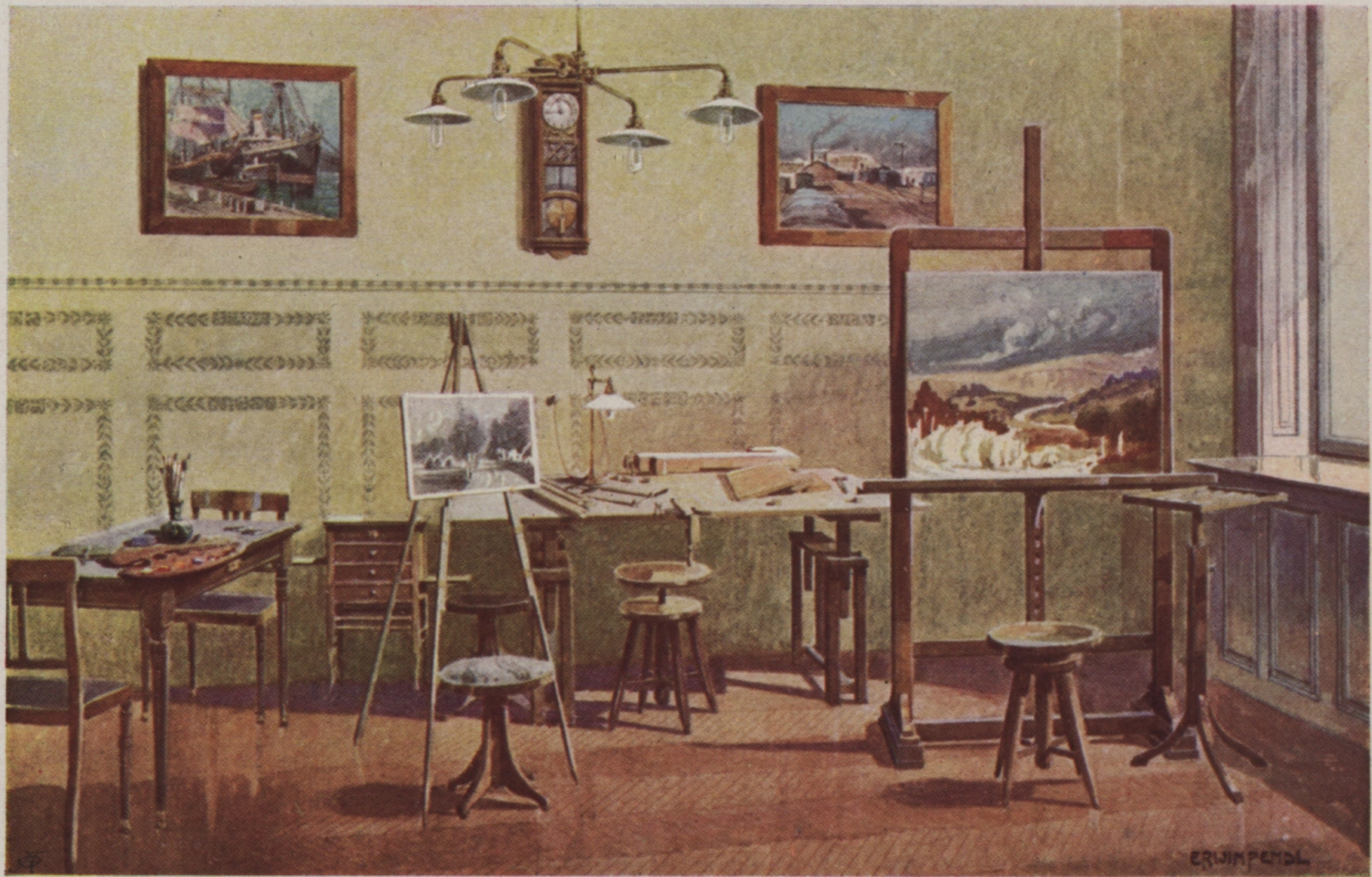

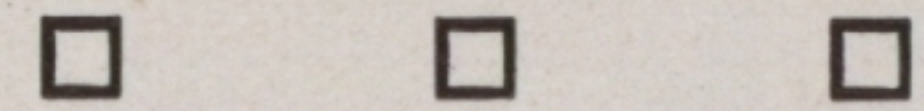

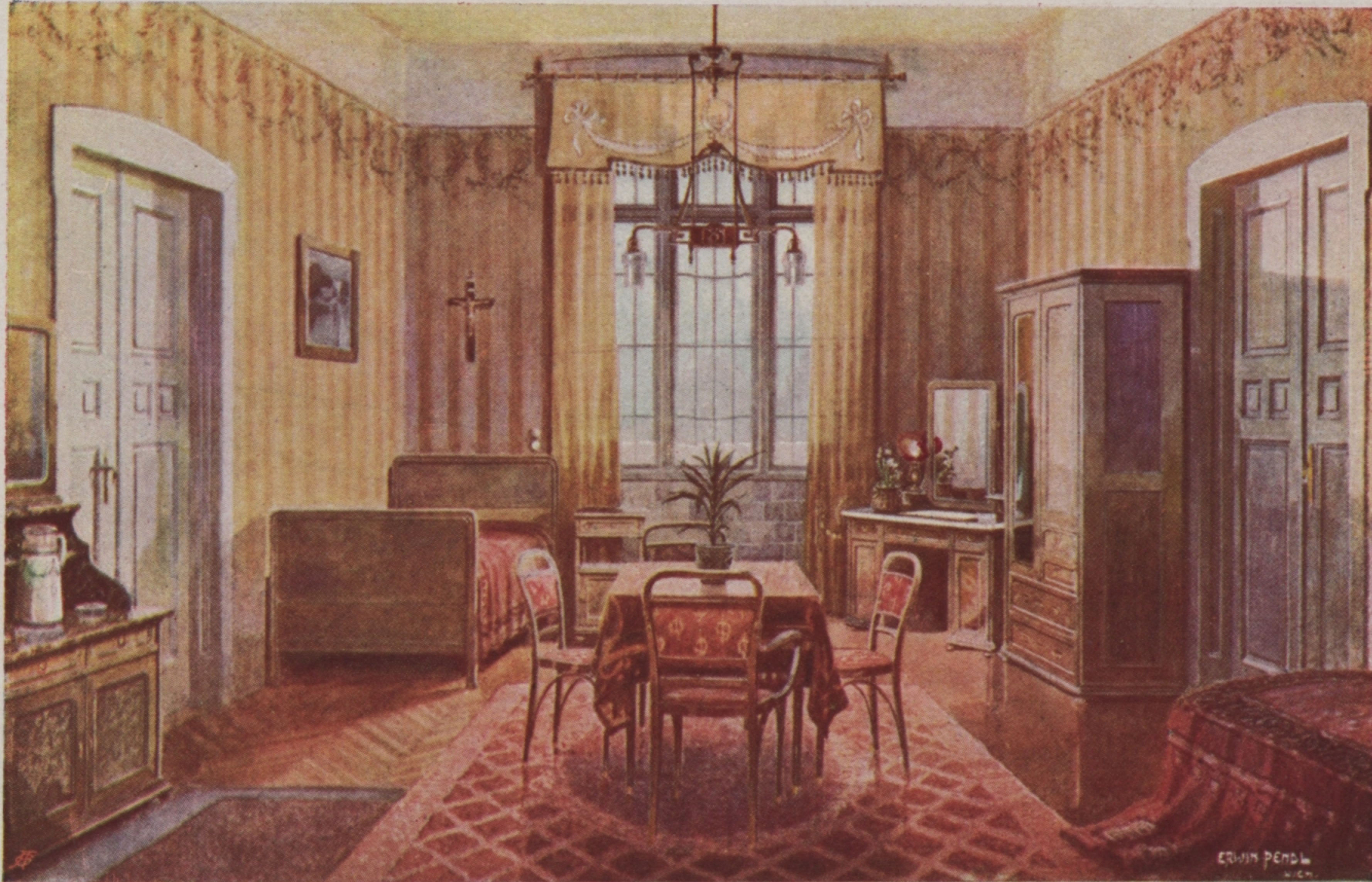

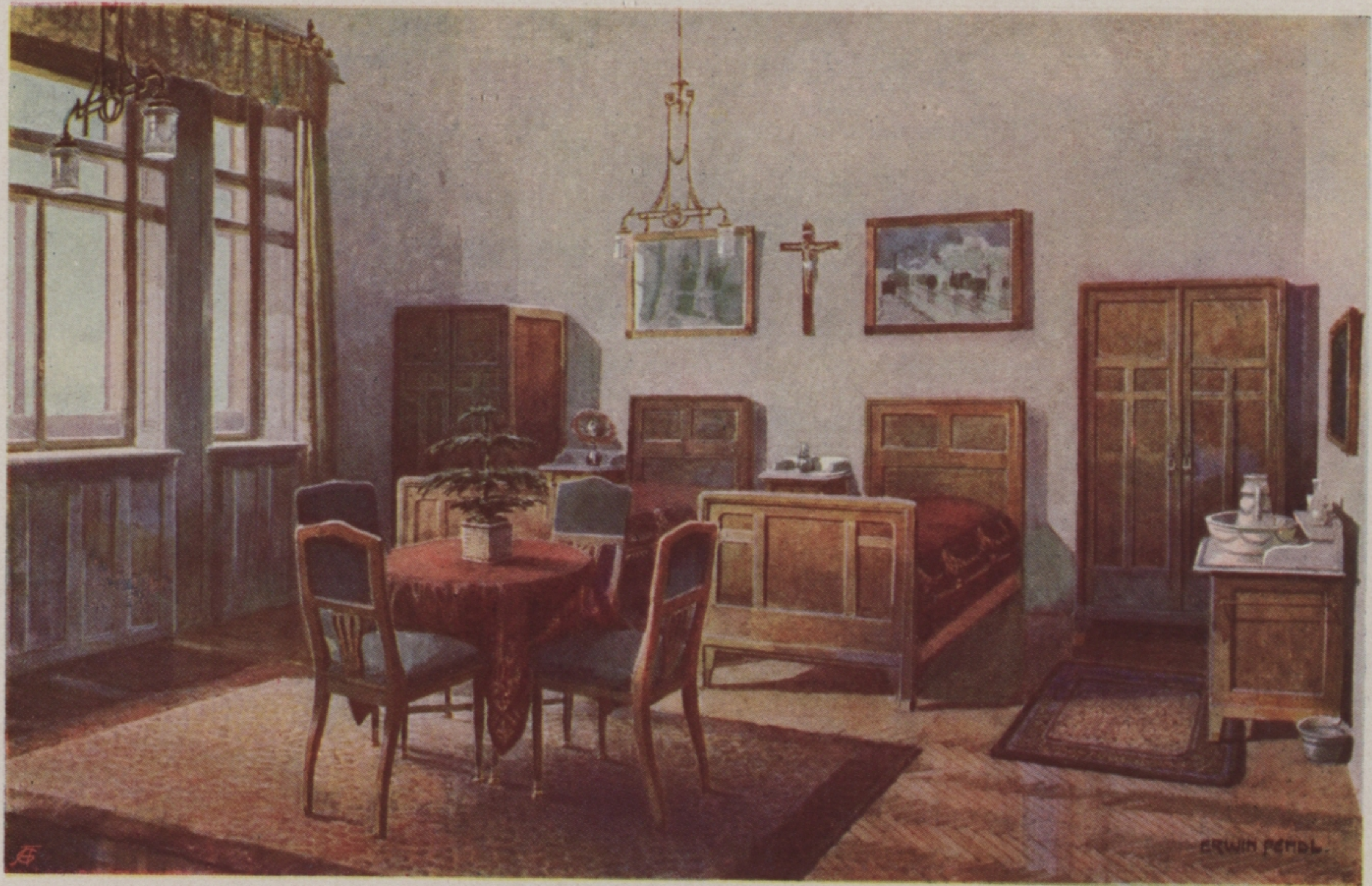

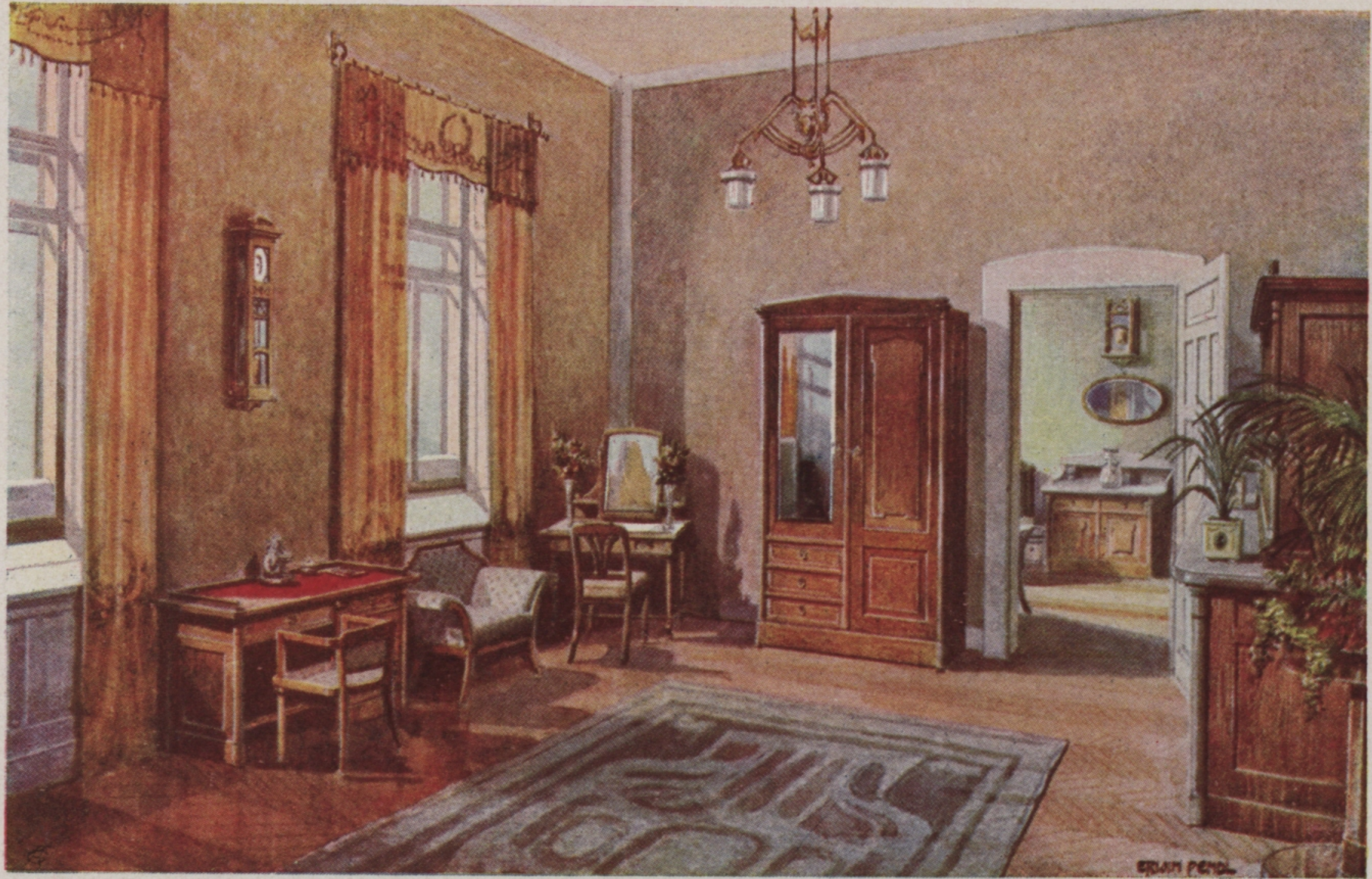

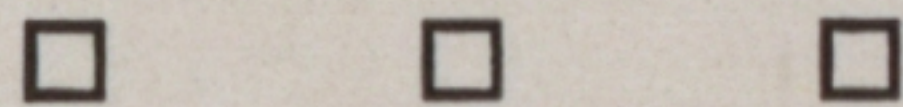

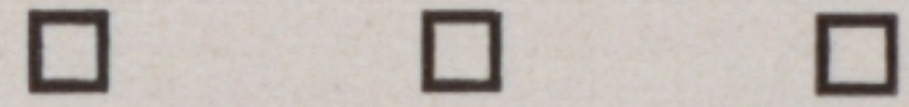

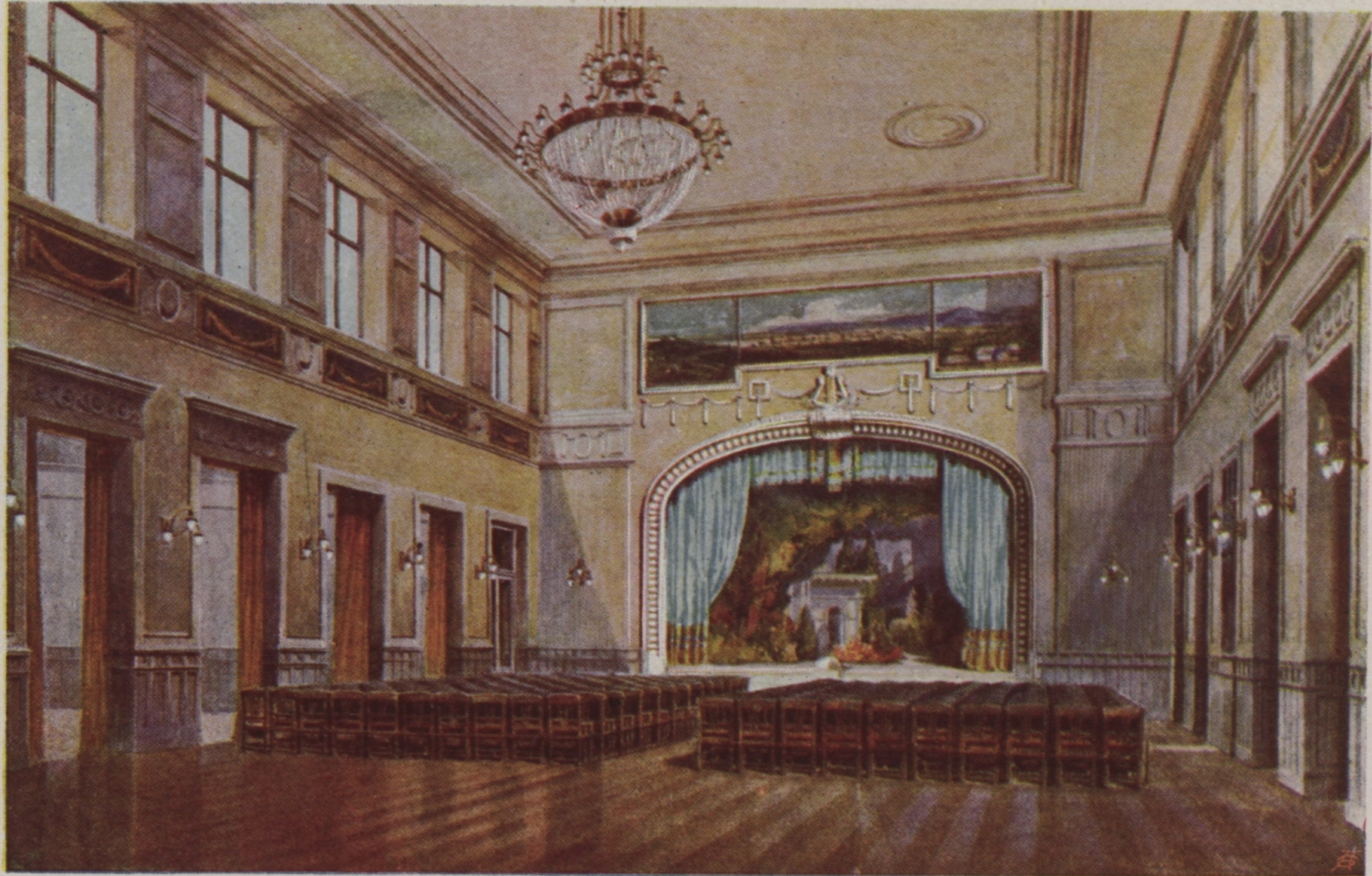

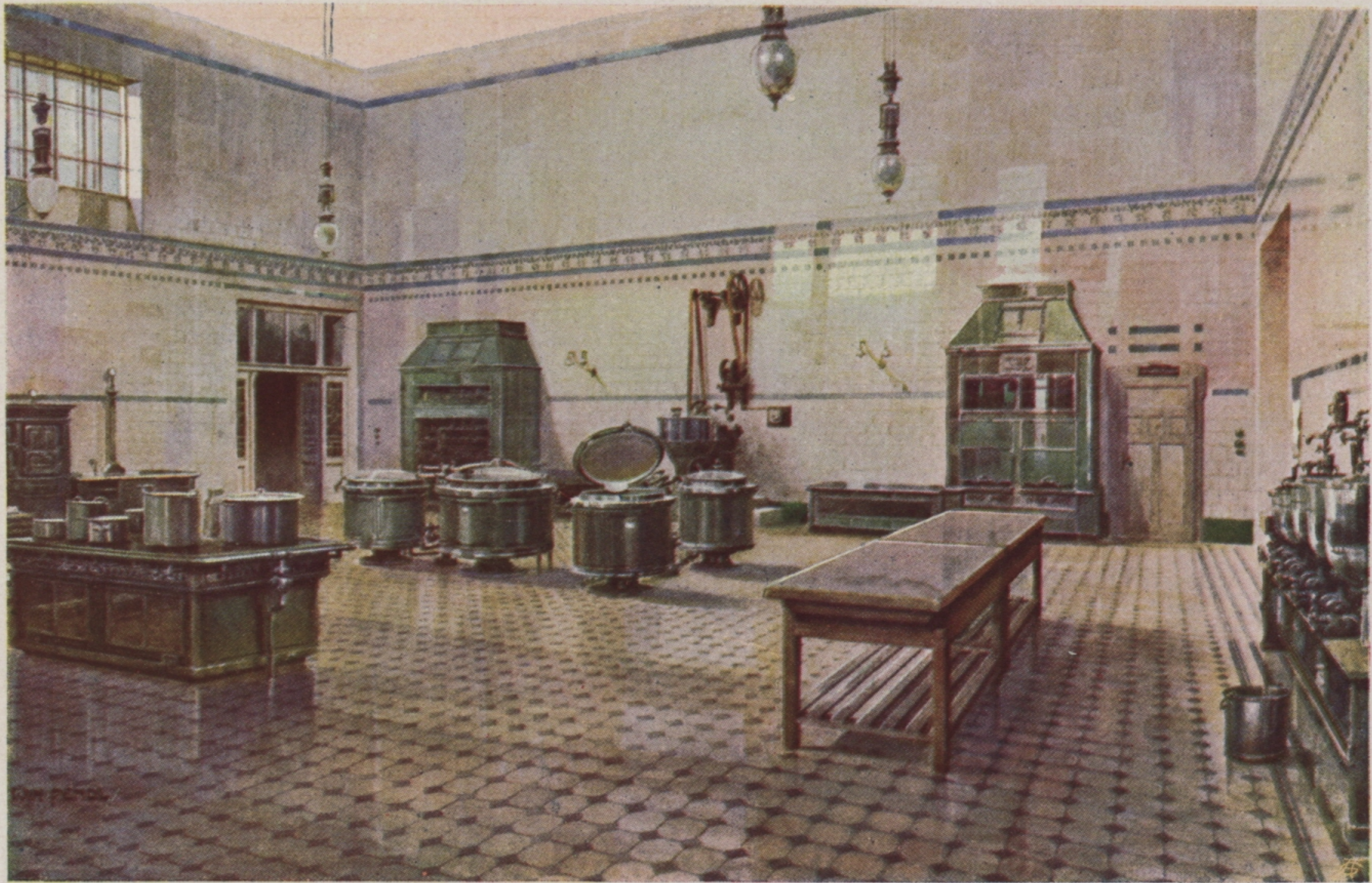

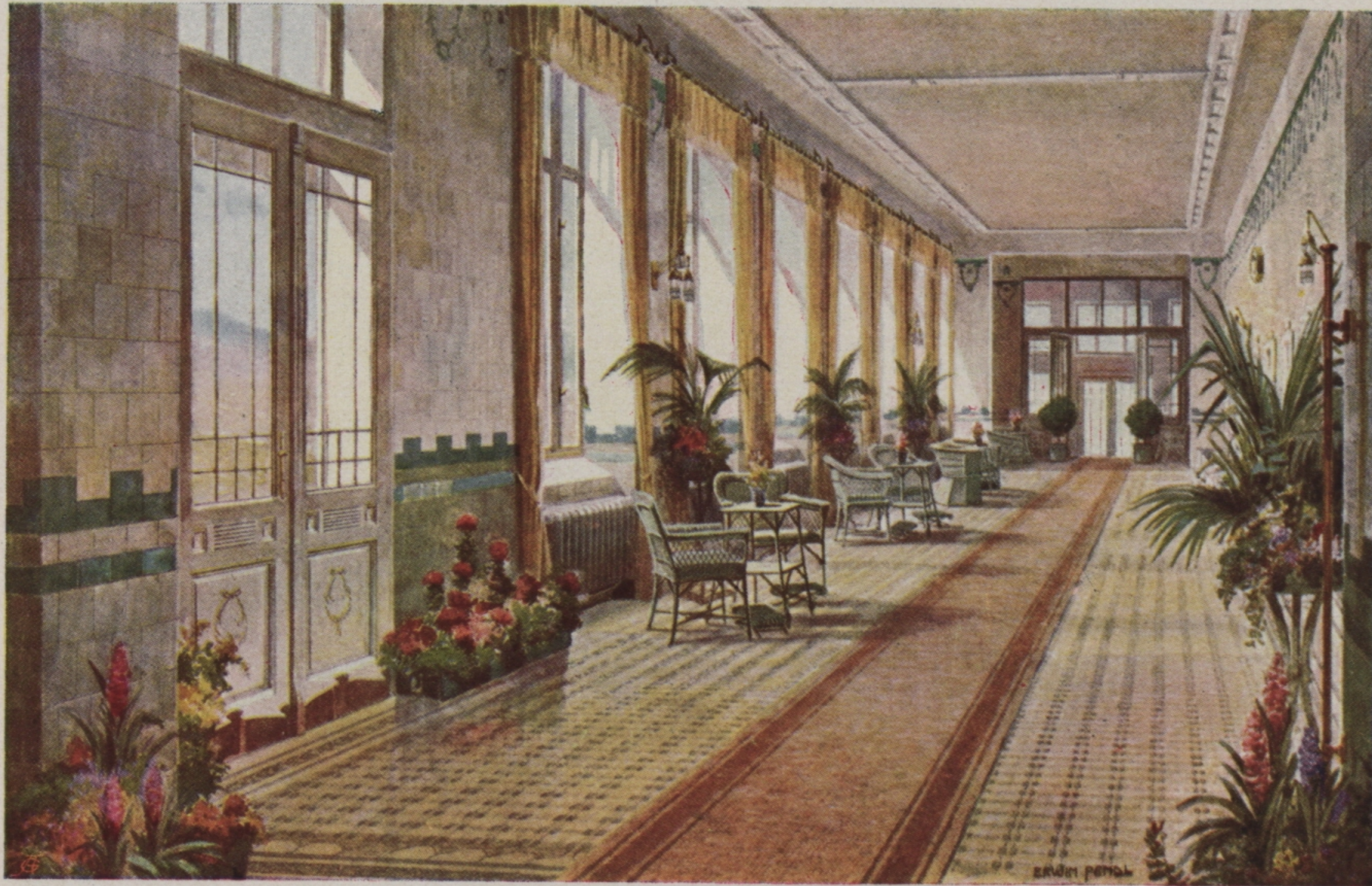

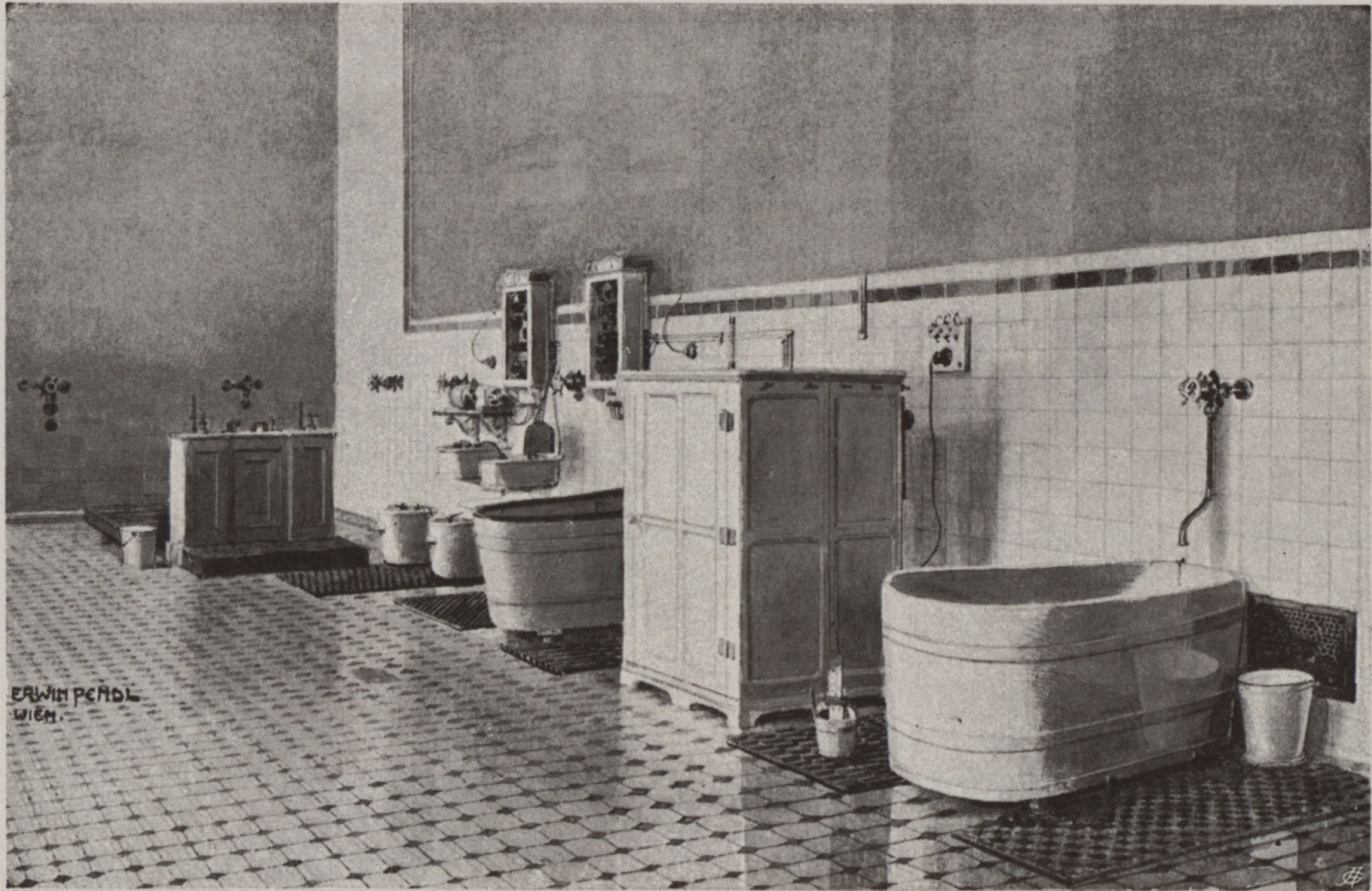

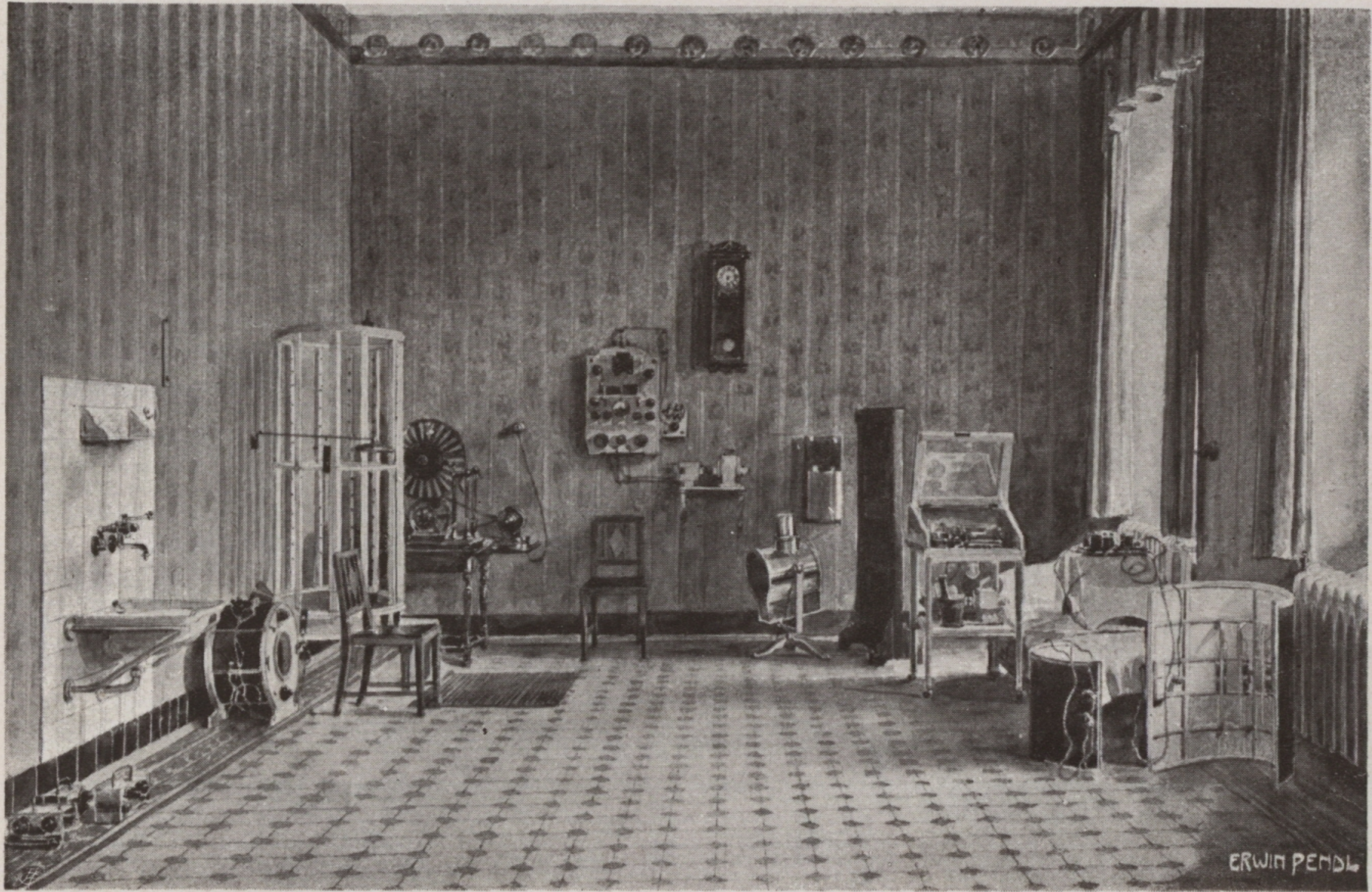

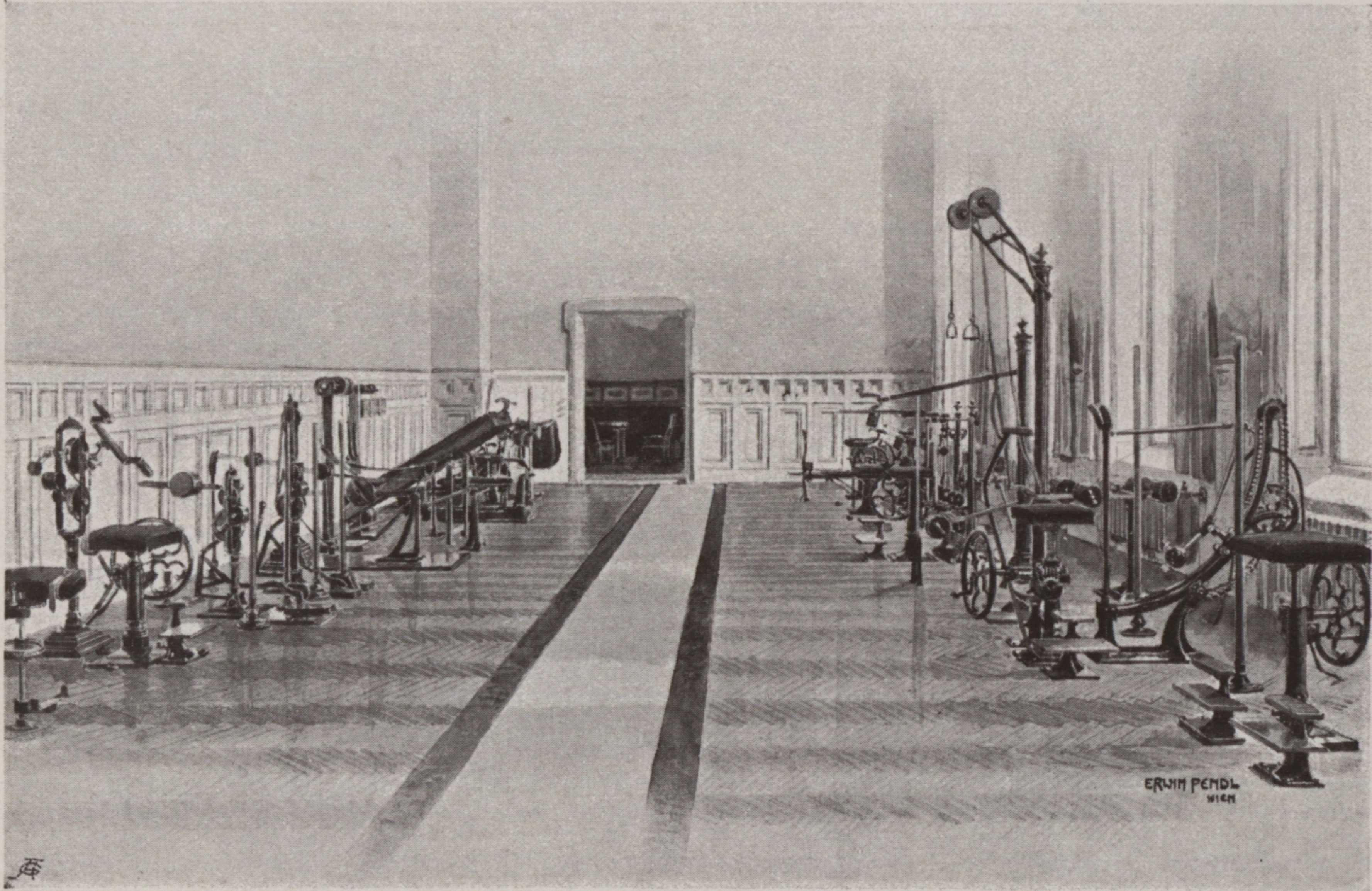

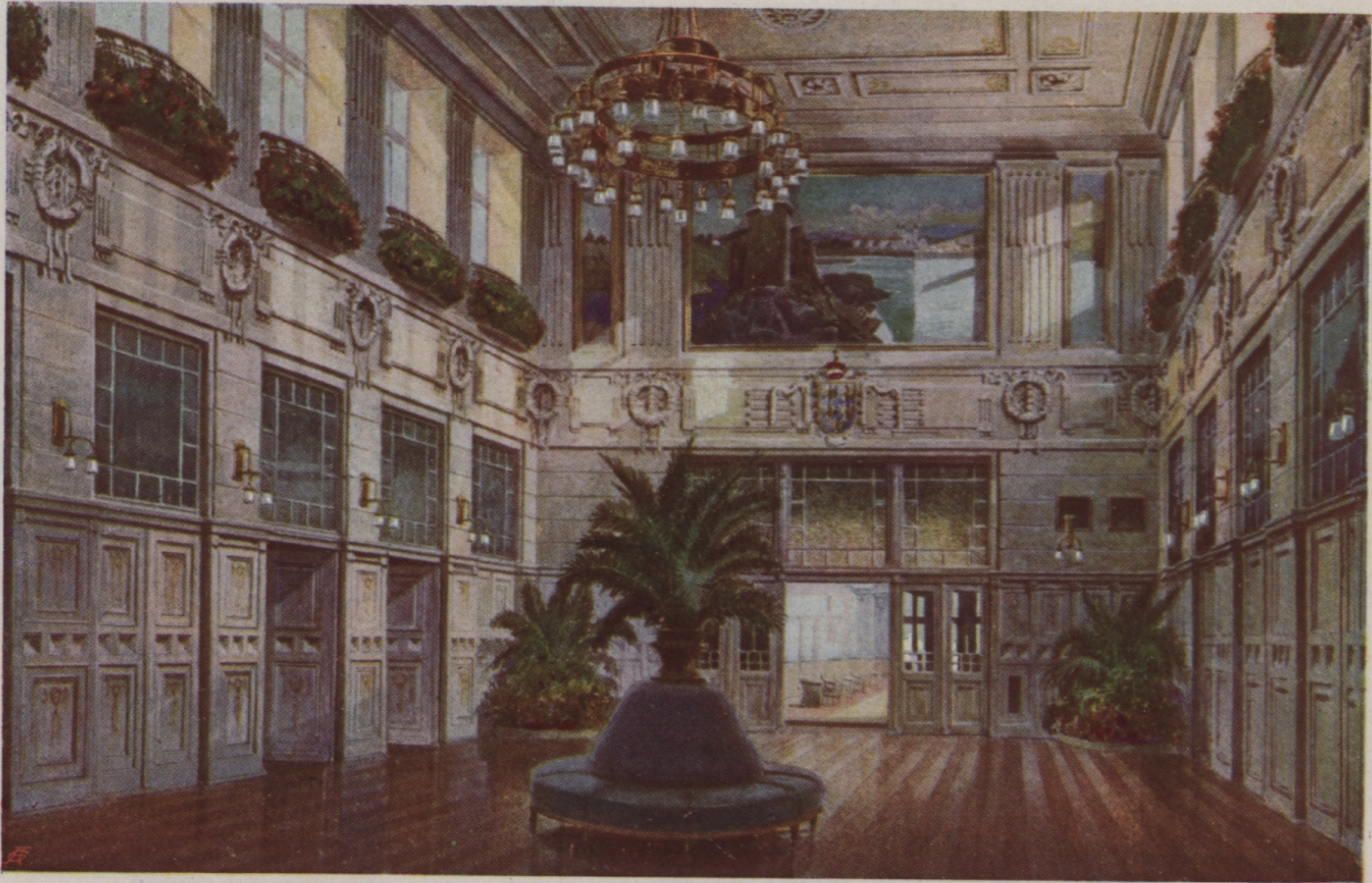

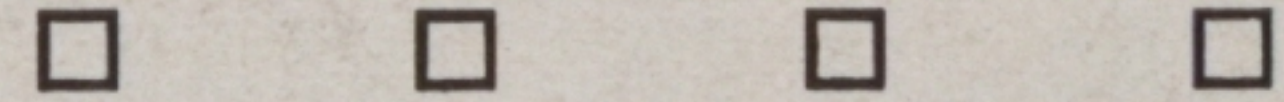

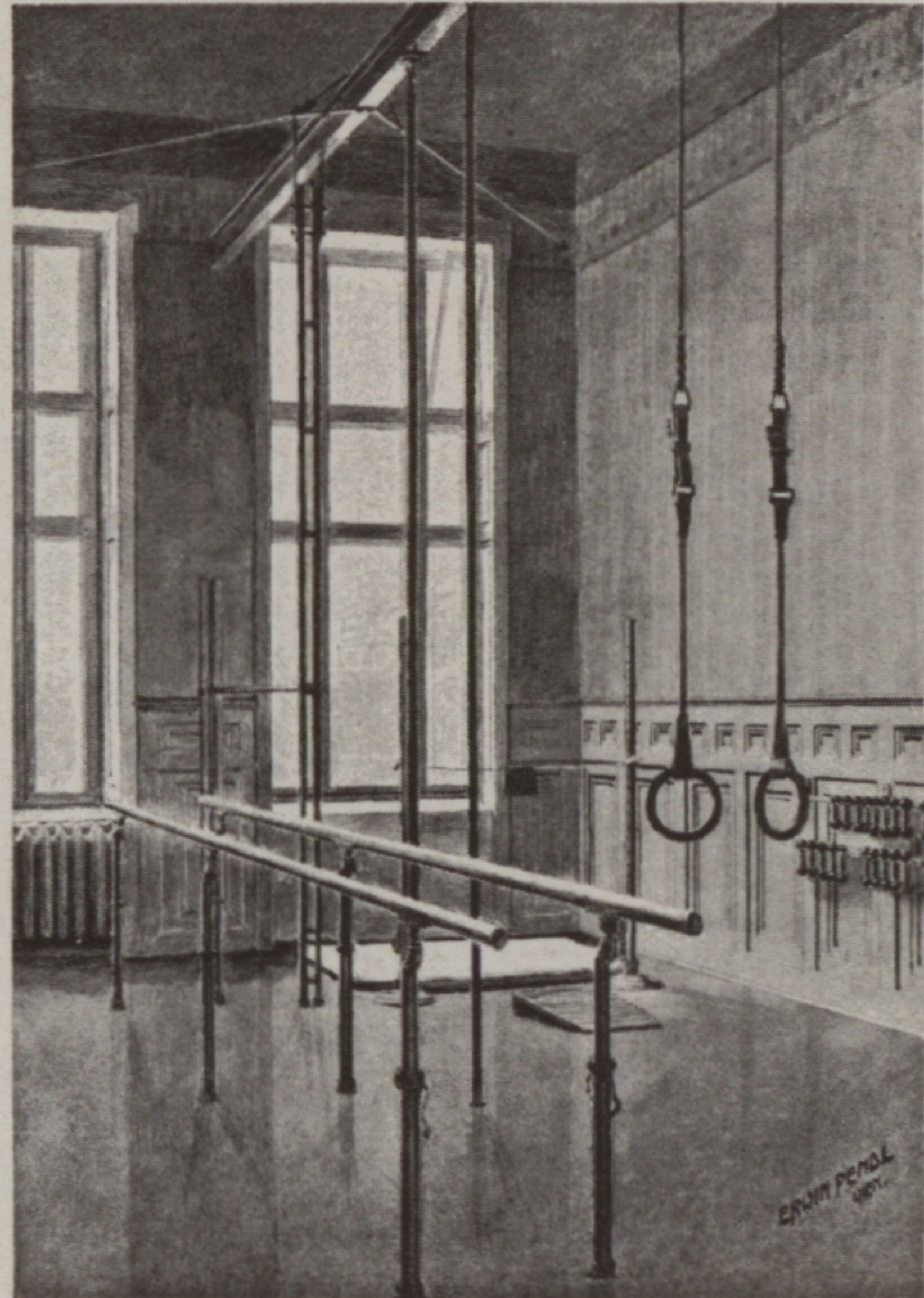
